Tuesday 10:00 am and 1:00 pm

Thursday 10:00 am and 1:00 pm

Tours are scheduled on a first come, first served basis. Requests can be submitted up to three months in advance. You are encouraged to submit your request as early as possible as a limited number of spaces are available. All Piper Aircraft tours are free of charge and tour length is approximately 1.5 hours to 2 hours.

(Please note that all tours may be subject to last minute cancellation).

Forms of Identification

All guests 16 years of age or older will be required to present a valid, government-issued photo identification (detailed below). Children under the age of 16 are **NOT** allowed in the manufacturing areas. All foreign nationals must present their passport. All other forms of foreign identification will not be accepted. All information submitted (e.g. name, date of birth, city, etc.) must exactly match the government-issued photo ID you will present when arriving at Piper Aircraft.

The following forms of photo ID are acceptable for presentation to receptionist upon entry to Piper Aircraft corporate headquarters.

- Valid government-issued United States identification card (e.g. driver's license, military ID, etc.)
- Valid United States or other official government-issued passports

No other forms of identification will be accepted; photocopies, expired IDs, or other transmissions of these documents are NOT valid.

Dress Code

We highly recommend all visitors to wear comfortable shoes such as sneakers or other non-slip footwear. They **MUST** be CLOSED-TOE. Open toe shoes and high heels are **NOT** permitted under any circumstance.

Safety Requirements

All visitors are required to wear appropriate safety glasses and hearing protection throughout the entire tour. These items will be provided to each visitor at the beginning of each tour. (No sunglasses are permitted to be worn inside the factory at any time.)

Prohibited Items

Prohibited items include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Video Recorders
- Food or beverages, tobacco products, personal grooming items.
- Strollers
- Aerosol containers
- Guns, ammunition, fireworks, electric stun guns, mace, martial arts weapons/devices, or knives of any size.
- Animals of ANY kind not permitted on site.

Photography of any kind is **NOT** permitted while on tour.

Piper Aircraft employees and officials reserves the right to prohibit any other personal items. Umbrellas, wallets, car keys, and cell phones (including those with cameras) are permitted. However, guests will not be allowed to use cell phones inside Piper Aircraft. Phones used inside Piper Aircraft may be confiscated by security.

Please note that no storage facilities are available on or around the factory.
